TRAINING...IT'S THE LAW!

Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 172, Subpart H, mandates training for individuals involved in the transportation of hazardous materials (hazmat). New hazmat employees must be trained within 90 days after employment. Recurrent training of all hazmat employees is required at least once every three years.

- General Awareness for Hazardous Materials Emergency Responders (1 or 2 Days)
Designed to equip emergency responders with a general awareness of how to recognize and deal with hazardous materials and the dangers associated with them during transportation.

- Cargo Tank Regulatory Compliance - \$675 (4 Days) Directed to those 49 CFR regulations that relate to shippers and carriers of hazmat by cargo tank.

- Transportation of Hazardous Materials - \$775 (5 Days) Provides a basic working knowledge of the hazmat regulations contained in 49 CFR.

 Sept 27-Oct 1, 2010 November 15-19, 2010

- Air Transportation of Hazardous Materials - \$675 (3 Days) Concentrates on the requirements and standards of ICAO/IATA and applicable parts of 49 CFR. (An optional 4th day emphasizing military airlift of hazmat is available.)
 February 2-4, 2010 August 17-19, 2010
- International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code (IMDG Code) - \$725 (3 Days) Focuses on "how to use" the IMDG Code. Areas covered emphasize the domestic and international transportation of hazmat by vessel.
 March 16-18, 2010 October 4-6, 2010
- Infectious Substances Transportation- \$425 (2 Days) Covers the requirements for shipping and transporting infectious substances, biological substances category B, biological products, regulated medical waste, and related exceptions. (A one-day course is available to on-site sponsors.)

NOTE: A working knowledge of the hazardous materials regulations is required to attend the following courses:

- Instructor Training: Hazmat Transportation Modules - \$ 675 (3 Days) This "train-the-trainer" course is designed to improve instructor skills, enhance understanding of the hazmat regulations, and give students a modular training program to use when training others. **A pretest is required.**

- Transportation of Hazardous Materials (Recurrent) - \$575 (3 Days) Enhanced instruction to provide recurrent (refresher) training for hazardous materials employees.
 January 20-22, 2010 May 25-27, 2010
 October 26-28, 2010
- Cylinders Transportation - \$575 (3 Days) Focuses on the requirements for offering, transporting, testing, qualifying, maintaining, and using gas cylinders as required by 49 CFR.
 March 23-25, 2010
- Explosives Transportation - \$625 (3 Days) Covers the shipping and carriage of explosives in accordance with 49 CFR.
 August 4-6, 2009 March 30-April 1, 2010
 August 31-Sept 2, 2010
- Performance-Oriented Packaging (POP)- \$575 (3 Days) Concentrates on the manufacturing, testing, marking, and use of UN/POP packaging in accordance with 49 CFR.

 October 19-21, 2010
- Radioactive Materials (RAM) Transportation - \$625 (3 Days) Focuses on preparing and transporting RAM shipments in accordance with 49 CFR.
 April 27-29, 2010 November 2-4, 2010
- Hazardous Wastes & Substances Transportation - \$575 (3 Days) Directed towards the shipping and carriage of hazardous wastes and substances in accordance with 49 CFR and 40 CFR. (This is not a RCRA course.)

- Preparing Hazardous Materials for Military Air Shipments - AFMAN 24-204(I) - \$300 (1 Day) Concentrates on the requirements of AFMAN 24-204(I), Preparing Hazardous Materials for Military Air. (This class is held in conjunction with Air Transportation of Hazardous Materials as the optional 4th day.)
