

## *the course*

The purpose of this course is to provide training to the regulated hazardous liquid pipeline industry in carrying out the requirements of the Federal Pipeline Safety Act (ACT) and subsequent congressional mandates. This course will help ensure that hazardous liquid pipeline operators design, construct, operate, and maintain their pipeline systems in a consistent and effective manner. Using the enhanced knowledge gained in this course and the appropriate use of 49 CFR Part 195, students will be able to operate and maintain hazardous liquid pipeline systems in compliance with the pipeline safety regulations. Students will be provided training that is cost-effective, convenient, and meets national standards.

## *the institute*

The Transportation Safety Institute (TSI) was established by the Secretary of Transportation in mid-1971 as an element in the efforts of the Department to reduce the number of transportation accidents in the United States.
