This course is designed to enhance the gas pipeline operator's general knowledge of the rules and regulations of 49 CFR, Parts 191 and 192, and how these rules and regulations apply to their particular system.

The primary thrust of this course is aimed at the application of a workable overview of certain key areas of Part 192, which experience has shown to be most often violated. Then determine whether or not the system is deficient in these areas and what means are necessary to correct the deficiencies.
